The School of Education at the University of Colorado Boulder announces a tenure track faculty position for the 2012-2013 academic year in Mathematics Education.

The School intends to hire at the Assistant or Associate Professor level, with consideration given to hiring at the Professor level when appropriate. Scholars of color are strongly encouraged to apply.

Responsibilities: Candidates for the position must be willing to contribute to teaching and program development in the teacher education and graduate programs, conduct research, publish in significant refereed journals, and seek outside funding. Candidates must be committed to working with culturally and linguistically diverse populations.

Salary: Commensurate with experience and scholarly record.

Mathematics Education: Candidates for this position must have an earned doctorate in mathematics education or a related field and must possess a strong mathematics background and experience with K-12 mathematics education. This faculty member will be expected to teach elementary mathematics methods courses in our teacher preparation programs as well as graduate level courses within her or his areas of expertise. The candidate must have an active research agenda, a strong publication record (commensurate with experience), and a track record or evidence of potential to secure external funding. We seek candidates with experience and expertise focused on student learning, teaching practice, learning technologies, teacher professional development, educational equity, or design of innovative curricula. Collaborations exist and are encouraged with other specializations in the teacher education program, with our local school district partnerships, and with other university departments. Preference will be given to individuals who have experience with culturally and linguistically diverse populations and to those with teaching and research experience at the elementary level. We are especially interested in candidates who have a strong commitment to working with pre-service and in-service teachers.
